

- **Drop Off and Pick Up Times:**

Monday – Friday: 7am to 5pm

Closed on all major Holidays: (kennel staff present for patient care – office not open)

New Years Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas

- **Copy of up to date veterinary administered vaccinations that include:**

Canine: Rabies, Distemper/Parvo & Bordetella (Kennel Cough)

Feline: Rabies, Upper Respiratory

If vaccinations are due, we can administer them while they are here with us.

(Vaccinations administered by breeders and/or done at home cannot be accepted)

- **Proof of preventative purchase of flea/tick control**

This can be in the form of an invoice from your veterinary office, receipt of store purchase or order history from online source.

If you are unable to supply the proof of purchase at the time of the boarding appointment, we will provide preventatives upon check-in at your expense.

If your pet's preventatives are coming due about the time of the boarding appointment, you can also bring them when you drop-off and we can administer them at the time of check-in.

- **Items to bring to help make your pet's stay more enjoyable:**

Their own food – This helps keep them on their normal routine and not have to do a sudden diet change that can cause GI upset. Also include an additional amount in case you need to extend their stay. We are able to accommodate both dry and can food. We have kennel dry food we can offer, if you choose not to bring their food. We will provide food and water bowls.

Medications – including preventatives, if due when they are staying with us. (daily fee for medications)

Treats (no raw hides please)

Small to medium sized beds/blankets/towels
